
Helpful Websites and Apps to support with...

Drawing With Carl APP – (Costs £1.99 but worth every penny) - We love using this in school to draw pictures.





ChatterPix Kids APP (Free)—to bring simple objects to life by drawing a move and recording your voice. Hours of fun...how creative can you be? Can you use this to test your knowledge? E.g. Voice a 2D/3D shape with properties.

Photospeak: 3D Talking Photo APP (Free)— Can you bring a character from history to life, an animal who talks about their habitat? I know P6/7 have used this APP so they may enjoy doing some topic work with this at home.





iMovie APP – should already be on apple devices – Use iMovie to create simple videos/animations

Green Screen by Do Ink APP – (£4.99 – but could keep them busy for a while – particularly P4-7) Use Green Screen to create simple videos/animations






Weave Silk — (Website) — Could help to explore symmetry also - http://weavesilk.com/


